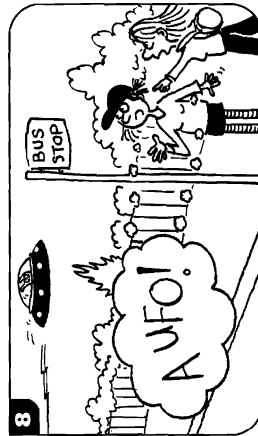
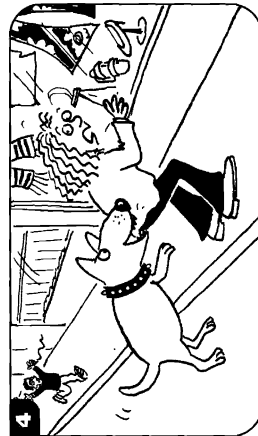
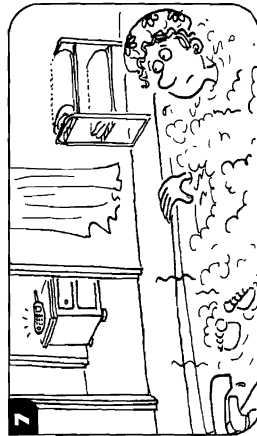
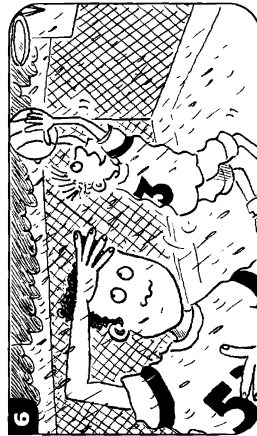
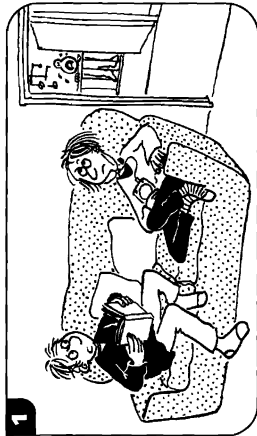


# What were they doing?
